A little about Evan:

Dr. Evan M. Rabinowitz is the founder of Yao Shan Center for Chinese Medicine in Washington, DC. where he has had an active clinical practice for the last 23 years. He is a professor at Daoist Traditions College of Chinese Medical Arts, Asheville, North Carolina. Evan served as Director of Chinese Herbal Medicine at the Maryland University of Integrative Health (MUIH) until 2018.

During his 8 year tenure he was instrumental in the creation of the University's Masters and Doctorate programs in Oriental Medicine. Previously, he was an instructor and Chinese herbal supervisor at the Academy for Five Element Acupuncture, Gainesville, Florida. He is currently a lecturer at Georgetown University School of Medicine within its integrative medicine and health sciences master's degree program, and has been a guest lecturer on Asian medicine and philosophy at various colleges and universities around the United States. Evan studied extensively with Jeffrey Yuen for two decades. He is a graduate of the George Washington

University (B.A.), Traditional Acupuncture Institute (M.Ac.) and Maryland University of Integrative Health (D.Ac.).

He has an active private teaching schedule, offering continuing education for practitioners across the country and internationally. Evan is the director of <u>Yao Shan Seminars</u>, an online platform for Chinese Medicine continuing education. Currently, he teaches an online, 10-month comprehensive training program in Chinese Herbal Medicine, <u>Yao Shan Herb Program</u>, in addition to his multiple online and in-person courses.

Course Outline:

Women and couples increasingly are turning to Chinese medicine to help them conceive and maintain a healthy pregnancy. Chinese medicine has been used for centuries to cultivate fertility and remove obstacles to conception. At every stage of the process, in a natural cycle or with ART, Chinese medicine offers powerful treatments to maximize the chances of pregnancy and, most importantly, the health of the mother. The essence of cultivating fertility is nourishing women's (and men's) health.

This course will focus on diagnosing and treating the major obstacles to pregnancy. Both acupuncture strategies and herbal medicine will be used to craft treatments. Pulse Diagnosis and Tongue Diagnosis with a special focus on gynecology will be presented. Treatment demonstrations with a focus on special needling techniques for the cultivating yin, invigorating yang, as well as eight extraordinary vessel needling techniques will be presented.

In this course you will learn to diagnose and treat:

- Ovulation Disorders: Polycystic Ovary Syndrome (PCOS), Thyroid imbalances from a CM perspective
- Uterine Blockages: various types of uterine stagnations including, uterine polyps and fibroids, fallopian tube blockages
- Pelvic adhesions: from endometriosis, surgeries and pelvic inflammatory disease
- Ovarian Insufficiency: from immune disorders or damage to the jing-essence As well as some of the more subtle blocks and to pregnancy

You will learn to:

- Flexibly use multiple herbal medicine formulas with precise modifications to treat common and complex obstacles to pregnancy
- Use multiple channel systems, including Eight Extraordinary Vessels, Luo Vessels, Sinew Channels to resolve major blockages to conception

You will increase your skills in:

- Pulse Diagnosis with specialty focus on gynecology: key pulse images and patterns for precision in diagnosis and tracking of treatment
- Tongue Diagnosis with specialty focus on gynecology: identify specific zones on the tongue for the female body and precise finding on the tongue for cysts, fibroids, uterine stagnations and much more!
